## FAQ's

- **What is the ADOS-2?** *The Autism Diagnostic Observation Schedule-2 is a semi-structured assessment of communication, social interaction, and play for individuals suspected of having autism or other pervasive developmental disorders.*
- **Who can administer?** *Clinical and school psychologists, psychiatrists, MSWs, OTs, BCBA's and speech therapists. But, it can only be used for diagnostic purposes by someone who is qualified to make the diagnosis.*
- **If I won't be using the ADOS in my daily work, why should I attend?** *The ADOS is the gold standard for ASD assessment so knowing it can help you review evaluations and understand what children are able to do and what they need to improve upon. You'll also be able to speak to parents more clearly about ASD and understand how diagnosing evaluators come to their conclusions.*
- **Who is the presenter?** *Elisabeth Sheridan, PhD, is an Assistant Professor of Psychology in Clinical Psychiatry at Weill Cornell Medicine and the Clinical Director of the Center for Autism and the Developing Brain (CADB). She is a licensed clinical psychologist with expertise in assessment and treatment of individuals with autism spectrum disorders. Dr. Sheridan also has extensive experience implementing evidence-based interventions including cognitive behavioral interventions for children and adolescents with ASD and anxiety.*
